## 2. Authors and affiliation

## 3. Structure of the manuscript

Title with a maximum of 15 words in Spanish, English, and Portuguese. Avoid abbreviations, acronyms, or quotations in the title and abstract.			
Structured abstract in Spanish, English, and Portuguese, maximum 250 words per language (objective, methods, results, conclusions) according to the <a href="#">PubMed</a> model.			
Include between 6 and 10 keywords in Spanish, English, and Portuguese, verified in DeCS/MeSH.			
The manuscript is structured as follows: Introduction (with the objective stated in the last paragraph), Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, and References.			

If it is a review article, the type is specified and it complies with international quality lists (Equator and standards).

URLs should not be included in the text, only in the list of references.			
It is recommended to incorporate bibliographical references in English to strengthen the international review.
